



Testing Concerns and Security Violations Report

This form is designed to allow individuals who have concerns about the administration of the Indiana Assessment System to notify the Indiana Department of Education of potential integrity and security concerns. All concerns that are supported by “articulable facts” will be further investigated. At the very least, the corporation/school against which the concern is raised will be notified of the concern (and provided a copy of this report), and the Indiana Department of Education will review with the corporation/school appropriate test administration procedures.

(Note: This form is not designed for use by corporations or schools to report a “Testing Irregularity.” The Testing Irregularity Report form in Appendix B of the Assessment Program Manual should be used to report irregularities that are not related to test security concerns.)
